

### ARTICLE III. - RESIDENTIAL BRUSH AND DEBRIS

Sec. 22-25. - Removal of brush and debris by the Town of Plain Dealing from any residence located within the corporate limits of the Town of Plain Dealing.

- (a) No brush will be removed and disposed of by the Town of Plain Dealing if a resident hires a contractual tree/limb service or individual. Contractors, whether bonded or non-bonded, are responsible for the removal and disposal of trees, tree limbs, etc., cut down on the resident's property. There are no exceptions.
- (b) All limbs must be cut to a length not exceeding six feet in length and must not exceed a weight of 50 pounds.
- (c) The weight and size of each item shall not exceed the capability of being picked up by two workers and must fit in the town's trailer; heavy equipment will not be used for residential debris removal unless in the event of an emergency.
- (d) Any leaves, twigs, pine straw, clippings, etc., must be bagged.
- (e) No construction materials, tires, hazardous materials, paint or paint cans will be picked up. There are no exceptions.
- (f) Appliance/furniture items will be picked up, but must be placed at the roadside.
- (g) No household trash will be picked up; this must be picked up by your garbage service provider.
