BOIL ADVISORY ISSUED FOR THE TOWN OF PLAIN DEALING WATER SYSTEM

The Town of Plain Dealing has issued a boil advisory for their water system. The advisory is for all Plain Dealing water customers.

Plain Dealing maintenance crews responded to an emergency water main blowout at approximately 4:00 this afternoon on Crabapple/School St. The four (4) inch water main likely failed due to environmental factors associated with older water lines. Water customers may experience low water pressure during repair time. Repairs are underway. All work shall be completed by 8:00 pm this evening.

The advisory is a precautionary measure, and Plain Dealing recommends customers boil their water for one (1) minute before consuming it until the advisory is rescinded. The advisory pertains only to water used for consumption. Again, the advisory is a precautionary measure and not a boil order.

Water customers will be notified when the advisory is rescinded.
