WHEREAS,

the Community Development Block Grant Program is among the few remaining federal programs available to address the needs of low and moderate income persons and small cities; and

WHEREAS,

the Community Development Block Grant Program has provided the state of Louisiana with important and flexible assistance to meet the needs of low- and moderate-income residents of small cities by funding sewer, water, street improvements projects, economic development projects, clearance/demolition, and Make a Difference projects; and

WHEREAS,

Congress and the nation acknowledge the critical value of the Community Development Block Grant Program and the significant projects that rely on its funds for support; and

WHEREAS,

the week of April 21-25, 2025, has been reserved for recognition and appreciation of the Community Development Block Grant Program
